Turning Point USA is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization founded in 2012 by Charlie Kirk. The organization's mission is to identify, educate, train, and organize students to promote the principles of freedom, free markets, and limited government. Turning Point USA believes that every young person can be enlightened to true free market values. Since its founding, Turning Point USA has embarked on a mission to build the most organized, active, and powerful conservative grassroots activist network on high school and college campuses across the country. With a presence on over 3,500 campuses, Turning Point USA is the largest and fastest-growing youth organization in America. TPUSA currently employs over 300 full and part-time staff dedicated to recruiting new activists, registering voters, and becoming major leaders of the movement in their community.

Charlie Kirk is the Founder and President of Turning Point USA, a national student movement dedicated to identifying, organizing, and empowering young people to promote the principles of free markets and limited government. With a presence on over 3,000 high school and college campuses nationwide, over 650,000 lifetime student members, and 450 full- and part-time staff all across the country, Turning Point USA is the largest and fastest-growing conservative youth activist organization in the country. At just 30 years old, Charlie has done thousands of media appearances and his writings can be seen on Fox News, The Hill, RealClearPolitics, Newsweek, The Washington Times, Breitbart, American Greatness, Daily Caller,

The American Mind, The Washington Post, and Human Events.

Charlie was previously named to the Forbes "30 under 30" list and was the youngest speaker at the 2016 Republican National Convention as well as the opening speaker at the 2020 RNC. He's the author of four books including the #1 Amazon and New York Times best-seller, "The MAGA Doctrine: The Only Ideas that Will Win the Future" from Broadside Books, an imprint of HarperCollins, and in 2022 he released "The College Scam: How America's Universities Are Bankrupting and Brainwashing Away the Future of America's Youth," from Winning Team Publishing. His upcoming book, "Rightwing Revolution: How to Beat the Woke and Save the West" releases in the spring of 2024. His social media reaches over 100 million people per month, and Axios has listed Charlie as one of the "top 10 most engaged" handles in the world. Charlie is the host of The Charlie Kirk Show podcast, which was downloaded over 120 million times in the last 12 months and regularly ranks among the top 10 shows on Apple News podcast charts. The Charlie Kirk Show is also a nationally syndicated live radio show heard on 150 radio stations around the country and is simulcast on Real America's Voice News. Collectively, The Charlie Kirk Show is listened to, watched, and streamed by an audience of over 1 million people every day.





Jack Posobiec is the host of Human Events Daily. Everyday, Posobiec brings the latest breaking news from coast-to-coast on one of the highest rated podcasts and shows in the conservative movement. He is also the Senior Editor of Human Events, which is a political news and analysis outlet founded in 1944. Posobiec is a frequent guest host of War Room with Steve Bannon and The Charlie Kirk Show.

After graduating from Temple University, Posobiec spent 2 years living in China working in international business and learning to speak fluent Mandarin Chinese. Posobiec is a veteran intelligence officer of the United States Navy with

multiple deployments including Guantanamo Bay and East Asia. In 2014, he joined the Office of Naval Intelligence as an officer at the Kennedy Irregular Warfare Center which provided intelligence to Navy Special Warfare and Navy Expeditionary Combat Command. Posobiec completed his final deployment in 2016 as the Intelligence Director for Navy Expeditionary Forces Command Pacific - Task Force 75.

Posobiec has written three non-fiction books: Citizens for Trump: The Inside Story of the People's Movement to Take Back America, all about the 2016 presidential election, 4D Warfare: A Doctrine for a New Generation of Politics, a handbook on political information operations, and Antifa: Inside the Black Bloc, about his investigations infiltrating the Antifa phenomenon in North America and their history. Posobiec's life was the inspiration for the graphic novel, Agent Poso by Chuck Dixon and Brett Smith. Originally from the Philadelphia area, Posobiec now resides in Washington, D.C. with his wife Tanya and their two sons.

Benny Johnson founded TPUSA Productions in 2018 and recently won an Emmy Award in original storytelling. Benny has hosted an array of shows and is currently the host of The Benny Show' Podcast streaming live to his 10+ million followers every day and his original viral videos have racked up over 5 billion views. Benny previously hosted 'The Benny Report' on Newsmax TV and held Editorial positions at The Daily Caller, IJR, National Review, TheBlaze, and BuzzFeed. Before starting his political media career, Benny was raised in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, and graduated from the University of Iowa. Today, Benny proudly broadcasts from the free state of Florida after personally escaping communism in Washington D.C.









Alex Clark is the host and creator of Culture Apothecary with Alex Clark, a top 10 worldwide health and wellness podcast where she interviews experts on healing a sick culture—whether that's physically, emotionally, or spiritually. Known for asking all the questions the listener is thinking, Alex has built a reputation for interviewing guests and experts with counter-cultural beliefs, no matter how controversial they may be.

As a powerful voice for women navigating the complexities of health, wellness, and culture, Alex's insights have resonated with audiences nationwide. In September 2024, she addressed the U.S. Senate with RFK Jr. on a panel about chronic illness,

adding her voice to critical conversations about healthcare reform and standing up for millennial moms struggling to raise healthy families in America today. Alex has also been profiled in The Washington Post, protested at Kellogg's headquarters over their use of artificial food dyes, been mentioned by NBC News, The Atlantic, Page Six, The New York Post, Fox News, interviewed by The Skinny Confidential, and more.

Riley Gaines is a trailblazing athlete and advocate, making waves for Gen Z with her passion for fairness in women's sports. As a 12-time All-American swimmer at the University of Kentucky, she has shown what dedication and hard work can achieve both in and out of the pool. Riley's bold stance on ensuring equal competition and protecting the integrity of women's athletics has made her a powerful voice in today's culture. As a Contributor for Turning Point USA, she brings not only her athletic achievements but also her fierce commitment to standing up for what's right. Born in North Korea, human rights activist and TED Talk Speaker Yeonmi Park grew up in a punishing society devoted to the worship of Kim Jong-II. At the age of 13, she and her family made a daring escape to China in search of a life free of tyranny. In her viral talks, viewed online nearly 350 million times, Park urges audiences to recognize and resist the oppression that exists in North Korea, and around the world.

Growing up in Hyesan, North Korea, it was normal for Yeonmi Park to see dead bodies as she walked to school, and to be so hungry that she ate wild plants. After watching a pirated copy of Titanic, the veil of tyranny began to fall. Having caught a



glimpse of a free world, Park realized that her experience of life wasn't the only one—and that she might one day find a way out. In 2002, Park's family suffered a crucial blow when her father was arrested and sent to a prison camp for engaging in "illegal trading"—selling materials that no one would be punished for in a free society. In 2007, Park's sister escaped with a friend before she and her mother followed her to China but before they could locate her, Park and her mother were sold separately to Chinese human traffickers. In 2009, Park and her mother crossed the Gobi desert to Mongolia from China in -40-degree weather, finding their freedom in South Korea. Yeonmi recounts this incredible story in her searing memoir, "In Order to Live: A North Korean Girl's Journey to Freedom," and in the insightful, moving talks based on her experiences.

An insightful and candid speaker, Park is fast becoming a leading voice of oppressed people around the world. At the Oslo Freedom Forum and the One Young World Summit in Dublin, she became an international phenomenon, delivering passionate and deeply personal speeches about the brutality of the North Korean regime. Her address to One Young World on the horrors of detention camps, political executions, and sex trafficking was viewed over 320 million times. The BBC named Park one of its "Top 100 Global Women."





Brandon Tatum is a former police officer turned influential conservative voice, known for breaking down complex issues in a way that's real and relatable to Gen Z. With his background in law enforcement and his no-nonsense, straight-talk approach, he's become a powerful commentator on everything from personal responsibility to unity and patriotism. As a Contributor for Turning Point USA and co-founder of BLEXIT, Brandon brings a unique perspective on law enforcement and criminal justice reform, offering credibility and insight that resonate with young conservatives. His ability to simplify big issues and connect with diverse audiences makes him an invaluable voice for TPUSA's mission. By empowering Gen Z to think critically, speak boldly, and drive real change,

Brandon continues to inspire the next generation of leaders to stand up for what's right.

Before joining the TPUSA Contributor team, Jobob worked for almost a decade as a political consultant and communications director for various political campaigns around the country. chart placements and recognition as one of Mississippi's top 5 rappers. His success is rooted in his life mantra from Proverbs 18:16: "Your gift will make room for you and bring you before great men." Topher uses his lyrical talents to create music with a purpose beyond financial gain, resonating deeply with followers worldwide without extensive news coverage or sponsored promotion.

His latest single, "Pray for Me" featuring Mihanks, promotes unity, inspired by the collective prayers for NFL player Damar Hamlin's health scare. Overcoming a speech impediment, Topher has built a successful independent career, standing strong against major label pressures. Despite a temporary ban of "The Patriot" on select platforms due to his political affiliations with then-President Donald Trump, Topher continued to rise. aiming to leave a legacy symbolizing limitless possibility and the power of faith.

Topher's journey exemplifies that with God in your life, the past does not define your future.

To avoid possible reproduction and legibility issues, alternative logos have been developed for applications with limited space. Use these miniature logo variations when they appear at 1-inch width or less.

A minimum amount of clear space — equal to the size of the "T" — must surround the logo at all times. Whenever possible, use a larger amount of uninterrupted space for optimal visibility.

Do not change, alter, crop or distort the logo in any way.
